Dear Starwalker Egypt Traveler,

Warmest greetings! We are very pleased that you will be joining us on this unique adventure of a lifetime to Egypt. We have put together this packet in the hopes that it will answer most of your questions and address your needs. Please read through the information carefully, as it contains many timely and important details of our journey. We like to be diligent with our tour organizing, so all our guests have the best experience we can offer them. Below is the registration document and also a suggested list of helpful hints for your journey with us.

Please take the time to read this important document.

Personal guidance for trip planning is available if desired. Please contact William any time during office hours.

- * Please fill out and return the enclosed registration form to William Henry right away which, along with payment, confirms your place on the tour and enables us to make the necessary tour arrangements, including your flight from Cairo to Aswan return.
- * For Couples, please fill out separate registration forms per person.
- * On booking your flights, send a screen shot of your itinerary to our office as soon as you reserve your flight, so we can arrange transport for your arrival and departure.* Please note, a fee will be charged for taxi pick up, if you arrive outside the 48 hours pre-tour itinerary pick up, or later than the 48 hour post tour itinerary departure. Thank you.

To ensure a great trip, we would like to offer a few suggestions on traveling to Egypt:

BEHAVIOR:

Please respect and nurture one another. We are soul family. Please be on your best and kindest behavior throughout this journey. It is a sacred pilgrimage that can be truly life changing. When this journey is complete, you will have reconnected with soul family that will be very dear to your hearts and you may remain in contact for years to come. Past tours to Egypt have confirmed this. When Egypt calls, the guest is ready to take that exciting step forward and delve into the secrets of this ancient land. Doors open, one starts to remember their own links to Egypt in past lives and on returning to the Mother Land, life is never the same again. Often, whatever is blocked in your own life, becomes unblocked and clarity takes form. Our wonderful guests over the many years of leading our tours, have all said the same thing, "A wonderful, life changing experience with like minded souls, fit for an Egyptian king or queen. Far exceeded my expectations, I will return". Dr T. S. Uk.

DOCUMENTS:

All participants are required to have a valid passport to be carried on your person or stored safely at all times. It must be valid for at least 6 months post-departure. It is a good idea to photocopy the picture page to carry in a separate place in case of loss and to also keep a copy at home. A visa is required for entry into Egypt. If you are a US, Canadian or British citizen or a member of the EU, you can bring \$25 in cash and get it at the airport in Cairo (no picture is necessary). You can get one from your nearest Egyptian embassy, however it is much more of a hassle, costs more, and requires relinquishing your passport for some time. It is quick and easy on the arrival into the Cairo Airport.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS:

We will be happy to assist you in selecting flights to Cairo. Once you have your tickets, please send William your flight itinerary as soon as possible so we can arrange for you to be picked up by our Cairo partners at the airport, the day before or day of the tour starting. Depending on your arrival times, you may also choose to schedule an extra night at our Cairo hotel, The Mena House, at the beginning or end of your journey. If you fly in to Egypt earlier than the start of the tour, please remember to book your own hotel accommodation sooner than later and let William know your arrival date and time.

Prices vary depending on hotel and travel season.

**TRIP INSURANCE:

A journey of this nature is a financial investment.

Trip cancellation insurance can cover your losses on nonrefundable air and land costs on trips cancelled due to personal or family illnesses or unforeseen documented

emergencies. It also covers the cost of emergency evacuation from remote areas in an unlikely scenario. A more expensive "Cancel for any Reason" policy is also available and what most of our guests prefer to purchase. You must buy trip insurance within 14 - 21 days of the date you send in your deposit (depending on the plan you choose) in order to receive certain benefits, including coverage for pre-existing conditions. Call William Henry's office for more information, or check with your personal travel agent. This insurance only covers US citizens departing from the US. We suggest non-US citizens look for a local agent.

We strongly recommend that all participants obtain short-term travelers 'Cancel for any Reason' trip insurance covering baggage, medical, accident/life and trip cancellation. We do not offer tour refunds for any reason.

PREPARATIONS/PRECAUTIONS:

There are no inoculation requirements at present for persons with flights originating in the US or Europe. However, it is advisable to consult your physician regarding your personal needs.

Doctors and medical facilities are available to us in most places, however we recommend each participant bring their own personal supplies plus any medication needed. Your good health and good physical condition will enhance the experience for you as well as the group.

CLIMATE/ CLOTHING:

The climate in Egypt is dry year around. March / April is a perfect time to visit Egypt. The evenings can get quite cool, especially on the river, and you will need a wrap at night. Occasionally it is cool in Cairo as well, while it can be quite warm or even hot in the south. Whatever the activity, women should remember that Egypt remains a conservative country and we wish to be respectful. Shoulders should be covered outside the hotels and boat (there are beautiful shawls available in Egypt). Comfortable, loose-fitting clothing are helpful for layering in the daytime. A light jacket or sweater for early morning, evening and also for the air-conditioning in the hotels is advised.

Wear comfortable walking shoes — sneakers or your favorite sandals with a supporting back strap, and cotton socks if you prefer, or comfy ankle boots to support your ankles. We will be doing a lot of walking. Pants are certainly acceptable for the women and are definitely recommended for camel or horseback riding. In the evenings, as everyone will be dining in very pleasant surroundings at our hotels, boat or local restaurants, somewhat nicer attire would be appropriate. Though casual is acceptable,

you might plan for at least one or two evenings of something more special to wear. We certainly have opportunities here to be festive, and we will have a chance to shop where wonderful, fun clothing can be purchased. Hairdryers are provided in all the rooms. Women often wear comfortable leggings, loose white linen shirts with waistcoat that can be removed at any time and boots to keep ankles protected when walking over the stone ground or rocky areas. Hats are mandatory for protection against the sun light.

BAGGAGE:

We highly suggest that you only bring one piece of checked luggage with you to Egypt and bring or buy an empty duffel bag for shopping goodies on your return. Most of our guests wish they had done this as the shopping is irresistible and they always leave with more luggage than they arrived with! If you bring two pieces of luggage with you to Egypt you will have no room on the return, so pack light and shop there! Remember to bring an extra set of clothes and your valuables in your carry-on for your international flight over, just in case. A daypack is often useful. Although you will never be required to carry your luggage, you will appreciate traveling light! The Laundry service is excellent in the hotels and on the boat.

COMMUNICATIONS:

Our 5* hotels have a business center and internet access in the rooms. The cruise ship also has internet access in the room. There are some Internet cafes available in Luxor and Aswan. International telephone calls from Egypt are easy to make, and can be dialed directly from our hotel rooms. They are much more expensive from Egypt than from the States, depending upon your international plan. We recommend that you get an international calling card from a reputable phone company that has an access number in Cairo, such as ATT or MCI.

If you are using a cell phone with international coverage, you can purchase a pre-paid SIM card in Egypt for your phone and use the local network, which will allow you to have a local # in Egypt and pay much lower rates. Please note: To be able to do this youneed a phone that can be unlocked for use with a SIM card, and that uses a carrier operating on the GSM network (Global Systems), such as T-mobile, with a frequency that will work in Egypt. 'WhatsApp' is free on your mobile and great for communication with friends and family.

ELECTRONICS/ CAMERAS:

Please note that the electrical current in Egypt is 220-240, with **European plugs** that have two rounded prongs. You will need an adapter in order to plug in your electric/

electronic devices. If you bring an appliance that does not have a built-in converter in the electrical cord (as most laptops now do), you will also need an electrical converter. Note: there are hair dryers in our hotel rooms, so you do not need to bring your own. If you are using a digital camera, you should plan to bring extra memory cards. There is very limited access to download your images while you are there unless you bring your own computer. If you are not using a digital camera, be sure to bring all the film and extra batteries that you will need as these are very expensive there. Likewise, film should be brought back to the states for developing. The film expiration date should be carefully checked and be good for at least one year from the date of purchase as it seems to deteriorate rapidly in Egypt's arid climate. Bring along a flash attachment with replaceable batteries if possible. This, along with your wide-angle lens, will produce the best results when photographing inside temples, pyramids and tombs.

MONEY AND CURRENCY EXCHANGE:

You will have no difficulty exchanging U.S. dollars into Egyptian pounds. Many banks in Egyptian hotels are open around the clock. We recommend waiting until you are in Egypt to exchange money. Egypt accepts and often prefers American dollars. Traveler's checks are a hassle here because you are required to show your passport in order to cash them, and many shops will not accept them. Hotels and some larger shops will take VISA (not as many take MasterCard). ATM's are becoming more convenient, although they are not as common in Egypt as they are in many other countries. The Mena House Hotel, Cataract Hotel and the Nile Hilton all have ATM's. The currency in Egypt is the Egyptian pound, which is equal to 100 piasters. Check http://www.xe.com/ucc/ for updates on the exchange rate. It is recommended that you carry some cash in large denominations and keep the rest in small denominations. Once currency is exchanged, it helps to carry many Egyptian one and five pound notes for gifting and tipping if you so choose to, whilst out and about. A money belt or other safe, secure means of carrying money and documents is advisable.

SUGGESTED THINGS TO BRING: PLEASE DO NOT OVERPACK!There is nothing less fun than carting around extra baggage. Keep in mind there is a wide range of things to buy at the markets.

- Light daypack for daily outings—helps to keep hands free
- Sunglasses and hat
- Swimsuit for pools in hotels
- Sunscreen and insect repellent
- Toiletries (must be compliant with TSA rules or placed in checked luggage)
- Earplugs (these can be very helpful)
- Masks, hand sanitizer, wash n'dry towelettes

- Tissues many public toilets lack paper. Useful on day trips.
- Small flashlight
- Camera
- Clothes that are comfortable and loose-fitting, keeping in mind Egypt's conservative culture. Good walking shoes, boots and comfortable sandals (ie. Teva) with back support• Electric plugs are the standard European type with two round pins. An adaptor is

adequate for most appliances. A converter is usually unnecessary.

- Personal reading material as space allows
- Intention, focus, and especially your sense of humor!

COST ADJUSTMENTS:

Tour costs are printed well in advance of our actual travel dates. In exceptional circumstances, the cost of your international trip may be subject to increases which we cannot absorb, due to reasons such as currency fluctuations, fuel costs, tariffs, dues, taxes and fees overseas, the costs of services overseas, additions/adjustments to the tour program, or developments beyond our control. We regret this situation and we do everything possible to avoid surcharges, but sometimes it is unavoidable. We reserve the right to adjust prices before the trip, as these changes are made known to us. An increase in tour prices shall not be grounds for refund of all or any part of payments made towards a tour, and completing the tour registration form constitutes your acceptance of this provision. For the record, in all the many years of leading tours, we have never had this adjustment to price prior to the tour.

PRICE AND PAYMENT:

The price for this 12 day, 5* luxury tour package is \$11,780. which includes 2 domestic Egypt flights, but not international airfare. The early bird price is \$10,600 if deposit is in by October 1, 2025.

If you do not wish to pay in full at the time of booking, you may pay in two installments, no later than dates specified:

- 1. First installment: The deposit of \$5,000 is required on booking, to secure your position on this trip.
- 2. The second installment must be paid at any time, but no later than the following payment schedule (after the deposit has been made): Please note, service providers in Egypt require dated guest payments to prepare for your arrival, so late payments jeopardize your place on the tour.
- 3. Second Installment: Final payment of \$5,600 is due before February 1, 2026.

If you choose to pay in full by check or money order you will not have to pay the \$270 credit card service fee/convenience fee that will be added to the tour price.

This is not a discount, it is an added bank charge. The deposit is non-refundable.

Please register early, as Egypt is a popular destination

and accommodations must be arranged well in advance. Space is limited. Our last two Egypt tours were sold out early with 32 pax in each. Tour costs are based on a minimum of 16~20 participants, double occupancy, and are subject to change. We reserve the right to decline anyone who does not fit the intention of the tour.

5*Hotel Only, Single Supplement Please make enquiry for availability in writing. For those guests wishing to book their own private room, Single supplements are always available in all the 5*Hotels but the Single supplements for the boat, are only available in the event that the tour does not sell out and that is rare. Per our Terms and Conditions, we will hold the registration open until 60 days before the date in order to try to match you with someone. If by that date we have not been able to do so, you will be responsible to pay for the hotel room single supplement plus the 4 day, 5* boat supplement if available. Price of boat supplement is given only if boat is not full and single room is available on a first come, first serve basis.

We try hard to avoid this extra expense for our guests, so on the boat,

Hotel single supplements are paired with single supplement guests. This is one of the top, exclusive, cruise ships in the world. Rooms are limited. Please try to register early if you would like to be matched with a roommate. Single supplements sell out quickly, book early to secure your place.

4 x BOAT SUITES AVAILABLE.

There are four stunning Suites (2x Presidential and 2x Royal) on the boat if a guest would like to upgrade. Price on application. First come, first serve basis. TIP PAYMENT

Tipping is expected and appreciated everywhere we visit and stay in Egypt. The service we receive is excellent. Universal tips for guides, boat staff, coach, hotel baggage staff, restaurants etc, for **15 day tour is \$450 cash, per person.** This fee is collected at the start of the tour and distributed daily throughout the tour by event manager on your behalf. Please do not send to our office, it is handed out daily in Egypt for universal tipping over the two week tour, on your behalf.

CANCELLATION POLICY:Please note, No refunds will be issued for any reason. We strongly recommend

'cancellation for any reason' trip insurance. In the event of a guest cancellation, please put in writing to our office for confirmation, so we can assist you in filing all insurance claims.
